Meetings are at 7:30pm, beginning with time set aside for a Resident's Forum. Questions should be directed to a committee member:



Beware the Copperhead!



It's the time of year for Copperhead sightings in Reston, including BWW. No reports of bites have been made yet, but Copperheads have been known to attack when threatened. To be safe while outdoors, especially when the leaves begin to fall, please take note:

The Northern Copperhead is a native to Virginia and it's the region's only venomous snake. A triangular head and vertical slit pupils identifies this pit viper, with patterns of brown crossbands over a body which can be copper, orange, or pinkish-brown and can grow over four feet long.

Copperheads inhabit rock outcroppings, woodpiles and debris. Their young are born late summer to early fall and have a yellow-tipped tail as lure to attract small animals. Its typical diet is frogs, toads, salamanders, beetles, cicadas, grasshoppers and caterpillars. �
