Painting Your House

For our cluster, there is only one exterior house finish allowed: Olympic Solid Color Premium Acrylic Latex Stain – it's important to note that this is not paint, and is actually wood stain. Locally, it is sold at Lowes (closest stores being in Sterling and Chantilly) and unfortunately isn't available at our nearby Home Depot.



Homes stained with an original palette color may be re-stained with that same approved color indefinitely. Should a homeowner wish to change color only a color from the new palette may be used. You cannot have the same siding color as your closest neighbors.

Trim surrounding window and doorframes is also Olympic Solid Color Stain and only two colors are approved. Gutters, roof troughs, roof flashing and fixtures must all be stained/painted one of the trim colors. Downspouts may be painted either the trim color or the same as the siding.

Original: Beachwood, Beige Gray, Butternut, Chamois, Cocoa, Russet, Sage.

Neighborhood Pool

Our neighborhood pool, Tall Oaks, opens Memorial Day weekend, with the following hours from May 29 to June 25:

Weekdays 3pm–7pm

Weekends 11am–7pm

June 26 to August 22, the schedule shifts

Weekdays Noon–8pm (closed Tues)

Weekends 11am–7pm

For the remainder of the season, August 23 to September 6, the pool is only open on the weekends from 11am – 7pm.

Reston Association Pool and Tennis Passes are necessary to gain admission to the pool. Passes are available now at the RA Member Services Desk, 1930 Isaac Newton Square (M-F 8:30-5:30), or online at www.reston.org.

Membership cards are \$15 for adults 18 years or older and \$10 for children. Family Pass Packages are offered for \$60 (2 adults and 3 children). Season Guest Passes are \$30 and are good for one guest per visit, while One-Day Guest Passes are \$5 each (available in packs of five) at the pool or RA main office, valid only for the day purchased.

RA Members 18 years and older must have a current photo ID and proof of owning or occupying a residence (upon which the RA assessment is current) in order to purchase passes for themselves and immediate family members. ❖

Trim: Mahogany, Oxford Brown

All door colors (original, equivalent, and new), except the last two, are Duron Glossy Enamel.

The original color names have been discontinued but the hues are the same as the equivalent Duron colors shown here:

Doors painted with an original palette color may be re-painted with that same approved color indefinitely. Should a homeowner wish to change color, only a color from the new palette may be used.

The main and external closet doors should be painted the same approved color.

A front storm door, if installed, must be painted the same color as either the front door or the trim.

Big thanks go out to Joanne Henck for working with the Duron store to obtain the equivalent matches for our original paint colors. ❖

Tried and True Recipes

Melted Brie with Fruit and Nuts

1 whole round of Brie: Cut in 1/2 crosswise, like cake layers

Mix:

2 tbsp. maple syrup

1/3 cup chopped almonds

1/3 cup cranberries, dried (can substitute any dried fruit, really)

1 Small apple, chopped

Put 1/2 the mixture on the first layer of cheese, top it with the second layer and put the other 1/2 of the mixture on top.

Place Brie in a 350-degree oven on a baking sheet for 10 minutes or until melted around the edges. Transfer to serving dish and enjoy with crackers or bread.
