A Message from the Board President: Thank you to those who attended the recent Annual budget meeting on October 7th. The proposed new budget was discussed and passed with only 4 residents in opposition. It is important to recognize that the main reason for the increase is the increase from our service industries, i.e., trash removal. landscape maintenance and snow removal.

WATER TURN OFF TIME. As the winter season

approaches, we remind you that turning off the outside spigots can prevent a burst pipe. This is especially important if you have pipes extending through a garage or under a deck. The shut-offs one each for front and rear. are somewhere in your laundry/utility room, usually near the ceiling. Locate the valve and close it. Open the outside faucet and let it drain. Open the very small bleed valve on top of the shutoff valve. It is a knurled screw about 3/8" in diameter which does not need to be taken completely off. \*Continued on next page.

As you ride and walk the cluster, take notice of how some home owners take great pride in their properties. You will see mulched foundation plants and bedding, leaves blown to the curb for pick-up. plants neatly trimmed, and no tree branches are lying around. It's really lovely to walk along and see the pride that's visible here in our cluster. Let's make it contagious this year. It would take not more than 2 hours outside on a nice day to clean up the average back yard. And our trash company

will happily cart them away if you don't have a wood burning fireplace or know someone who does. Organize a group clean-up by working with your neighbors. Everyone will benefit from the outdoor air and exercise, and the yards will be tidied up as a result. Be mindful. though, that we live in a state with a poisonous snake - the Copperhead. To date a number of areas have reported bites to people and their pets. We have NOT had any incidents in BWW but being

cautious is still a good idea. If you have a stone wall or riprap in your area, proceed with caution. Though the sound of the leaf blower is not as easy on the ears as the sound of leaves being raked, using one will give you less chance to come across one of these critters.
