Be on the lookout while walking the paths, in the yard, or working in the garden. They can't hear, but they feel vibrations, so stomp as you go.


If bitten by a Copperhead, immediately go to the nearest hospital for treatment.

Parking in the Cluster

All vehicles parked on the Cluster Property must be licensed and insured with current tags and inspection stickers for the Commonwealth of Virginia. This is a requirement of Fairfax County.

Parking is only permitted in designated spaces and no more than two (2) vehicles per home may be parked on Cluster property at any time.

Curbside parking is for loading and unloading only and vehicles parked at the curb unattended are subject to being towed at the owner's expense. Parking overnight at the curb is NEVER permitted and vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense. Your neighborly compliance with these rules will make our Cluster a nice place to live. ❖

Wildlife in the Cluster

Homeowners have reported seeing a fox and a raccoon strutting about our neighborhood looking for food. Please be careful and if you see one of these furries, don't get too close. ❖

Fairfax County Car Tax

The Fairfax County government has mailed out more than 800,000 personal property taxes on vehicles, with the bills coming due on Monday, October 7th.

In addition to the tax itself, vehicle owners must pay registration (decal) fees of \$33 for vehicles less than 4,000 pounds, \$38 for those more than 4,000 pounds and \$18 for two-wheeled vehicles.

Payments can be made by mail, online through the county government's Web site at http://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/dta, and in person at the Fairfax County Government Center. Tax relief is available to some county residents due to age or disability.
