Switching light bulbs is one way to conserve energy in your household. Incandescent bulbs are inexpensive but are highly inefficient and put out as much as 90% in waste heat.

Compact fluorescent (CFL) and LED bulbs have come a long way in the past several years and are much more efficient, requiring only a fraction of the energy of a comparable incandescent to produce the same amount of light and some can last up to 20 years. 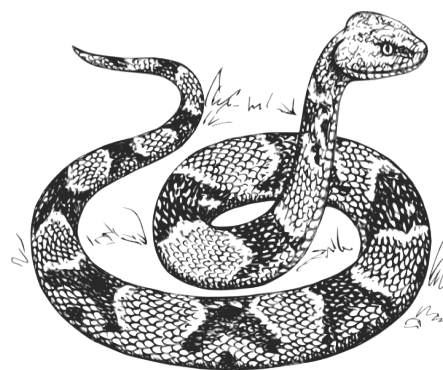
