Frozen Pipes?





This winter has been one of the coldest on record. With older homes such as those in our Cluster, it's important to prevent frozen pipes by shutting off and draining outside spigots. However, if you turn on the water and only a trickle comes out, chances are you have a frozen pipe. To unfreeze the pipe, keep the spigot open while you locate the frozen section. Use a hair dryer or heating pad to slowly warm the pipe. If you can't locate the frozen section or, worse yet, the pipe has burst, close the spigot, turn off the water to the house, and call a licensed plumber right away.



New Tot Lot Climber

Just as the weather started getting colder, our cluster welcomed its latest addition: a new climbing structure for the tot lot located between Farsta and Scandia. This structure is the final installment in an effort to update all the playground equipment to more modern, safer structures.
